

The document below details regulations of the Abdullah Gül University /AGU) regarding undergraduate application dates and requirements.

Compliance with AGU's diploma and/or exam requirements does not guarantee obtention of a Diploma Equivalence Certificate (Denklik Belgesi) once in Türkiye. The Diploma Equivalence certificate is mandatory for registration to any Turkish higher education institution. The granting of a Diploma Equivalence certificate is at the sole discretion of the Turkish Ministry of Education.

International student applications to Abdullah Gül University are submitted directly through the official application portal. There are no partnerships with any agencies, and no application fee is required. All communication regarding applications should be made exclusively through the official email address: intoffice@agu.edu.tr.

Once students are accepted, a pre-registration deposit (full year's tuition fee) is required to finalize pre-registration. This deposit must be paid only to the official university bank accounts and not to any personal bank accounts.

General Certificate Education (GCE) A- and AS Levels certificate (Cambridge or Edexcel)	Either: - 2 A levels (min. C) - 1 AS level (min. C) - 2 O levels (min. C) Or: - 3 A-levels (min. C) - 1 O-level (min. C) Or: - 2 A-levels (min. C) - 3 O-levels (min. C) Candidates cannot submit the required O- and A-levels in the same subjects.
West African Examination Council (WAEC) or West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE)	Minimum B3 passes in each 4 subjects, including science subjects
Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE)	Minimum Grade Required: B-
Baccalaureate	A minimum score of 13 out of 20
TRYÖS	Having ranked in the first 5th percentile in the TR-YÖS exam taken by the applicant.
