Erasmus+ Higher Education Beginners Meeting organised by the Turkish National Agency was hosted by Alanya University.



Surpassing the world's most prestigious universities such as Cambridge, Oxford, and Yale, and being the only university from Türkiye to enter the rankings, Abdullah Gül University (AGU) achieved great success by being ranked 15th in the 2023 WURI Global Top 100 Innovative Universities list. AGU has also ranked first in the world in the Top 50 Student Mobility and Openness category of WURI 2023.
